You or your representative are invited to attend a Workshop on the Arizona Department of Transportation Policies and Procedures that apply to the use and disposal of PM-10 Certified Street Sweepers purchased with federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Implementation (CMAQ) Funding and the Draft 2010 CMAQ Methodologies. A copy of the ADOT Policies and Procedures for Federal Property Management Standards is provided in Attachment A and a copy of the Draft 2010 CMAQ Methodologies is provided in Attachment B.

The first topic to be discussed will be the ADOT Policies and Procedures for Federal Property Management Standards that became effective October 18, 2010. These policies and procedures establish uniform standards that govern the use and disposition of property acquired, in whole or part, with Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) funds or whose cost was charged to a project supported by a FHWA grant and apply to PM-10 Certified Street Sweepers funded through MAG.

The second topic to be discussed will be the Draft 2010 CMAQ Methodologies. These draft methodologies have been updated to include emission rates produced by the new EPA mobile source emissions model, MOVES2010, and include improvements to the methodology for Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) projects. These methodologies will be used for evaluating proposed projects for CMAQ Funding.
