4. CoC Strategic Planning Objectives

Members will continue discussion from the November 5th Planning Subcommittee meeting on developing short term (twelve month) and long term goals for meeting HUD's CoC Strategic Planning Objectives. The 2012 NOFA includes six objectives:

- 1) Create new permanent housing beds for chronically homeless persons.
- 2) Increase the percentage of persons remaining in permanent housing over six months to 80 percent or more.
- 3) Increase the percentage of persons moving from transitional housing to permanent housing to at least 65 percent or more.
- 4) Increase the percentage of persons employed at exit to at least 20 percent or more.
- 5) Increase the percentage of participants in all CoC funded projects that obtained mainstream benefits at exit to 20 percent or more.
