



STUDY OVERVIEW

Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG) is conducting a study to help provide member agencies with additional tools and guidelines to provide better transit accessibility for pedestrians and bicyclists. Goals of the study include:

- Identify the challenges faced by users getting to transit
- Recommend improvement concepts, policies and guidelines to enhance transit accessibility
- Provide a toolkit of measures and strategies for local governments to create transit accessible and livable neighborhoods
- Identify options and provide a regional framework for applying for federal grants

The project will ultimately provide a set of documents that will serve as a pathway for MAG member agencies to build livable and multi-modal neighborhoods.

STUDY TIMELINE

- **Winter 2011/2012** – Data collection and initial stakeholder outreach
- **Spring 2012** – Categorize bus stops & case studies
- **Summer 2012** – Develop Bus Stop Prototypes, Develop Implementation Strategies, and Financial Analysis
- **Fall 2012** – Present findings to stakeholders and receive feedback. Finalize recommendations and prepare final report
