SAFETEA-LU requires any agency applying for Section 5310 funds (Elderly Individuals and Individuals with Disabilities); Section 5316 funds (Job Access and Reverse Commute); and/or Section 5317 funds (New Freedom) funds; to respond to a locally derived human services transportation coordination plan. Agencies will demonstrate compliance with the FY 2011 MAG Human Services Coordination Transportation Plan Update as evidenced by the following:

- Attendance at designated human services transportation meetings to assist in the development and implementation of regional coordination planning.
- Compliance with information and data requests to aid in the collaborative efforts of the planning process.
- Demonstrated support and achievement of goals in the plan as appropriate and identified in the plan.

Strategies identified in the coordination process are the collaborative effort of all participating agencies. A successful and relevant plan will assist the agencies in their mission to serve elderly persons, and persons with disabilities and persons with low incomes.
