


# Google fiber City Checklist




The City of Phoenix was invited and is participating in the Google Fiber City Checklist project. This project allows Google to conduct a detailed study of factors that affect construction plans, such as topography (e.g. hills, flood zones), housing density, and the condition of local infrastructure.

Google has provided a checklist of items for Phoenix to complete to help make the city ready for Google Fiber. Google is asking cities to provide them with information that can speed up planning and construction (e.g. maps of poles, conduit, existing water, gas, and electricity



lines). Google also asks that Phoenix streamline processes (e.g. permitting procedures and access to local infrastructure) to make it easier for a construction process of this scale to move quickly.

The City of Phoenix team is working to complete the Google Fiber City Checklist by the May 1, 2014 deadline. All of the documents provided will undergo vetting by subject matter experts, City management, and Homeland Security staff to ensure sensitive data is appropriately handled and protected. In addition, City legal staff is preparing an extensive non disclosure agreement (NDA) to protect sensitive City data collected for this study. Scottsdale and Tempe are working on a similar submission.
