


Liberty Utilities Palm Valley and Sarival Water Reclamation Facilities Service Area Expansion 2014

- The 208 Plan Amendment was requested by the City of Glendale and Maricopa County.
- The service area expansion would allow portions of the Glendale Municipal Planning Area that include unincorporated areas of Maricopa County to be served by the Palm Valley and Sarival Water Reclamation Facilities located in the Goodyear Municipal Planning Area.
- The Water Reclamation Facilities are identified in the MAG 208 Water Quality Management Plan with reserve capacity to accommodate the service area expansion.

- **April 14, 2015 – State Water Quality Management Working Group recommendation**
- **April 16, 2015 – MAG submittal of the amendment to ADEQ**
- **Spring 2015 - ADEQ certification that the amendment is consistent with the MAG 208 Plan and the Arizona Water Quality Management Plan and submittal of the amendment to EPA for approval**
