Proposal Requirements

- Details on pages 6-8 of the RFP
- \$238,000 project budget Study Length
- Proposals due February 24, 2012 at 12:00 noon MST
- Submit ten (10) copies of proposal
- 30 page limit does not include cover letter, resumes, etc.
- Proposal must document any potential conflicts of interest
- Proposers Checklist on page 9 of the RFP

Evaluation and Selection Process


- Details on page 10 of the RFP
- RFP's will be evaluated by a multi-agency panel

Administrative Requirements

- Details on page 11 of the RFP
- Cost-reimbursement plus fixed fee contract
- MAG withholds 10% from each invoice until acceptance of the final product and invoice
- Contractor is required to comply with MAG insurance requirements

Project Overview

- Study similar to Southwest Valley Local Transit System Study that recently commenced
- Project Duration ~ One Year (Final Report Spring 2013)
- Develop short, mid, and long range local transit plan that effectively provides circulation within the northwest valley and also connects to the regional transit system. Identify strategies for paratransit, local routes, and circulators.

Project Overview ~ Key Points

- **Develop a comprehensive, phased, market-defined, fully integrated local transit system plan that effectively connects to the regional transit system**
- **Identify efficiency/effectiveness analysis of existing and future conditions**
- **Coordinate study with on-going regional transit plans and studies**
- **Phased steps for implementation of plan**
- **Lifeline level of service for each phase**
- **Sound financial plan**
- **Widespread community support for transit service**
- **Agency and Public Involvement**
