


## Requested Action

The City of Tempe is requesting that TMP13-101 be amended to increase the project area from 4.30 to 7.81 alley miles.

Should the action be approved the project would receive an additional \$229,825 in CMAQ from the FY2013 Closeout. This amounts to an 82% increase in the area to be paved for a 41% increase in total project cost


## Description of Revised Project

The Holdeman Neighborhood revised project area is bounded by Priest Drive on the west; Hardy Drive on the east; University Drive on the north; and Broadway Road on the south.

The proposed project area is approximately 1 mile west of the Maricopa County monitoring station located at College Avenue and UPRR. The approved project area was limited to 13th Street on the south. Extending the project area will result in cost savings for both the City and the region.
