To provide individuals with a safe and comfortable home in combination with services and supports that promote choices and opportunities for growth, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

Community Living Services provides instruction to adults with developmental disabilities by assisting them to achieve their maximum potential. As a part of the person-centered planning process, the individual works with his or her Individual Support Plan (ISP) team members to develop/plan the service outcomes. Skill training and evaluation is offered in the following areas:
