 - \$9.0 Million
- **Awarded Percentage**
 - 8.2%

2011 Results

- **Date of first discretionary NOFA**
 - June 2011
- **Time between NOFA and submittal deadline**
 - 4 – 8 weeks
- **Total number of grants submitted by region**
 - 5
- **Total Requested Funding**
 - \$135.4 Million
- **Total award**
 - \$10.4 Million
- **Awarded Percentage**
 - 7.7%

2012 Assumptions

- NOFAs with same criteria / funding requirement will be made available in 2012
- Timeline between released date and submittal date ~ 4 – 8 weeks
- Fewer applications / regional collaboration lead to greater success
- Repeat requests for funding can be successful

2012 Preliminary Timeline

- January – Transit Committee – Review of 2011
- Week of January 23 – Transit Operators Working Group Meeting
- End of February – Projects Verified for Eligibility/ City Council Approval (4 weeks/1 full month)
- February 24 – Local Application Complete (4 weeks)
- March 23 – Regional Application Complete(4 weeks)
- March/April – SGR/Livability Federal Submittal*
- March/April – Clean Fuels Federal Submittal*

* Dependent on continuing resolutions and NOFA release dates
