





# PHX Sky Train Service Levels

## Hours of Operation

- 24/7/365

## Travel Time

- 5 minutes - 44<sup>th</sup> St. Station to Terminal 4

## Frequency / Headways

- Train arrives every 3 – 4 minutes during normal hours

## Passenger Capacity

- 2, 3, or even 4 car train configurations to meet future demand





# Stage 1A

- Extends the System to Terminal 3
- Walkway connection to Terminal 2
- 3,000 LF Additional Dual-Lane Guideway
- No Additional Cars Required
- Further Reduces Congestion on Sky Harbor Blvd
- Stage 1A Complete early 2015





# Stage 2

## Extends the System to Rental Car Center

- Additional 2.5 miles of Dual Lane Guideway
- 2-3 Additional Stations
- 2 Additional Electrical Power Substations
- More Than Triple the Current Fleet

## Expansion of the MSF

- Maintenance Bays
- Expansion of the Yard Track
- Automated Car Wash
