1. Call to Order

2. Call to Audience  
Chairman Robert Maki made a call to the audience providing an opportunity to members of the public to address the Transportation Safety Committee. No comments were received from the public.
3. Review and Rank Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Project Applications from MAG Region  
Sarath Joshua told the committee that ADOT received 33 applications for SRTS grant of which 21 applications are from MAG Region. ADOT's process of project selection requires Regional MPO's / Council of Governments input in selecting projects from their region.

Sarath suggested that Safety Committee follow dell process in ranking the projects with ranking 1 for High important project and 2 for medium and 3 for low. The entire committee member expressed their consent over the ranking methodology. After 1<sup>st</sup> round of ranking everyone at the committee agreed to rank generated in 1<sup>st</sup> round and felt that they don't have to repeat the process. Kerry Wilcoxon moved a motion to recommend the projects as ranked and Jamal Rahimi seconded and it was unanimously carried to approve the motion.
