# EPA 8 HOUR OZONE NONATTAINMENT AREA PROPOSAL





- **2 violating monitors**
  - Humbolt Mountain - .087 ppm
  - North Phoenix - .085 ppm
- **40 exceedances**

# Timeline

---

- **July 15, 2003 - Governor's recommendation to EPA**
- **August - September 2003 - EPA Region IX meets with Headquarters**
- **December 3, 2003 - EPA notified states of any modifications**
- **February 6, 2004 - Additional information due to EPA**
- **April 15, 2004 - EPA finalizes nonattainment areas**
- **April/May 2007 - Plans due to EPA**
- **2007 or 2009 - Likely attainment dates for Maricopa**
