



# Study Purpose

- Formulate a strategic implementation plan consisting of innovative, but implementable, policy recommendations, finance techniques, and project delivery and administration methods




# Compilation of Statewide Transportation Improvement Concepts

- TransCAD Travel Demand Model Platform
- Utilize Available Data (MPO Travel Demand Models, HPMS, ADOT Regional Profile Studies, and others)
- Develop Common 2005 Base Year and Year 2050 Forecasts
- Incorporate Freight Travel





- Identify network deficiencies

# Role of Transportation Investments for Economic Well-Being




- Reinforcement and growth of economic activity centers
