



EXCEEDANCES OF THE ANNUAL PM-10 STANDARD Maricopa County, Arizona





PM-10 Issues

- **5 Percent Plan due Dec. 31, 2007 if standards not met**
- **Serious Area Plan Revisions**
 - Salt River SIP - Aug. 2004
 - Street sweeping issue
 - Diesel engine measure delay
- **SAFETEA - Add PM-10 to CMAQ Allocation Formula**





Lawsuit on Serious Area Particulate Plan for PM-10

- **Filed by Arizona Center for Law in the Public Interest**
- **Challenged EPA approval of the Plan**
- **Issues**
 - CARB diesel fuel
 - Stringent agricultural measures



9th Circuit Court Ruling

May 10, 2004

- **EPA properly determined that agricultural measures were Best Available Control Measures and Most Stringent Measures**
- **Court vacated portions of EPA's final approval of plan and remanded to EPA**
 - Whether rejection of CARB diesel fuel meets BACM and MSM
 - Extension of the attainment date since it is tied to MSM
