 - Bicycle, pedestrian, other modes.
 - Demand management.
 - Congestion management.
 - Safety.
 - Environmental factors.

- **Extends through FY 2028.**

- **Adopted in 2003 and updated in 2005, 2006, 2007.**



Alignments for new freeway, highway, arterial, and light rail/high capacity transit facilities will be determined following the completion of appropriate design and environmental studies.



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

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

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

Planned Regional Grid Bus System





Current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

- **Detailed project listing:**
 - Freeways.
 - Arterial streets.
 - Public transit.
 - Bicycle, pedestrian, other modes.
 - Stimulus projects.

- **Covers FY 2008-2012.**

- **Adopted in 2007 and amended periodically.**



Regional Transportation Planning Issues

- Regional transportation funding outlook.
- Cost to provide transportation services.
- Cost/revenue balance.
- Extend RTP through a minimum of 20 years.
- Update TIP for FY 2011 - 2015.



Long-Range (Life Cycle) Program Strategies

- Design policies and value engineering.
- Project phasing/re-scoping.
- Project deferrals.
- Funding source adjustments and revenue enhancements.
- Program management strategies.
- Delay project implementation.
- Implement reduced service levels.
- Phased capital facilities.



Key Steps

- **June 2009:**
 - Transportation public hearing with focus on transportation planning issues.

- **October 2009:**
 - Transportation public meeting with focus on freeway and transit life cycle programs.

- **March 2010:**
 - Draft RTP/TIP for air quality analysis.
 - Mid-phase open house and public hearing.

- **June 2010:**
 - Final Draft RTP/TIP.
 - Air quality conformity public hearing.

- **July 2010:**
 - Final RTP/TIP.
 - MAG Regional Council consider adoption.
