


What other projects are currently planned in the corridor?

Did You Know?

MAG and ADOT have identified several freeway improvement projects within the Spine Corridor (nicknamed "Near-Term Improvements") that are planned for construction over the next five years. In addition to the Spine Study's corridor recommendations, these improvements are needed and have been advanced toward construction to provide the greatest benefit to the community.

PROJECTS PLANNED THROUGHOUT THE CORRIDOR



CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS TO BE CONSTRUCTED BY 2020

Valley Metro Project:

- Northwest Light Rail Extension (along 19th Avenue to Dunlap).

ADOT Projects:

- Interstate 17 Active Traffic Management System enhancement.
- Interstate 17 auxiliary lanes (merge lanes) between I-10 (Split Interchange) and 19th Avenue.
- Interstate 10 between State Route 51 and US-60.
 - Adding one lane outbound (eastbound).
- Interstate 10 ramp improvements between SR-143 and US-60.
 - Relieves congestion by "braiding" ramps to minimize lane changes.
- Interstate 10 widening between Baseline Road and Loop-202.
 - Add one general purpose lane in each direction.
