Bus Service



Fleet of over 900 buses

- 57 local routes
- 22 express and RAPID
- 18 neighborhood circulators
- 2 LINK routes
- 1 rural route



Connector Route – Route 685

Ajo/Gila Bend to Phoenix



Route 685 travels between Ajo and Phoenix Monday through Saturday, excluding major holidays. Fares range between \$2.00 - \$8.00. If transferring to Valley Metro system-wide bus or light rail service, additional fares apply.

Flex Stop Service Available. Choose your own pick-up and drop-off location up to ¼ mile from the regular route. Restrictions apply. Call 1.800.242.9483 for details.



Dial-a-Ride

Origin to Destination – shared ride service

- Types of service
 - ADA

Federally mandated public transportation service for people unable to independently use the bus of their trips.

- Non-ADA

Not required-service availability varies



ADA certification process

- In person assessment
- Lifetime eligibility for some customers
- Standard certification is 5 years
- ADA bus and rail pass for some customers in participating cities
- Referral system to taxi subsidy and other transportation options
- Referral to travel training program: one on one instruction


- Cab programs
 - Coupons for Cabs (Chandler, Gilbert, Mesa and Tempe): co-pay \$2.50/book valued at \$10, Mesa residents pay \$3.50/book
 - CAB Connection (Scottsdale): up to 16 vouchers/month per user
- Mesa Mileage Reimbursement – Mesa senior citizens & persons with disabilities are eligible to apply for mileage reimbursement up to 300 miles/month

City of Phoenix Senior Cab and ADA Cab Program

- City of Phoenix residents age 65 and over and those who are ADA certified
- \$10-voucher books for \$3 apiece
- Can buy a maximum of \$12 to receive \$40 worth of taxi vouchers monthly
- Vouchers can be used for one trip, combined with cash fares to travel further, or banked over several months for a longer trip
- Riders are responsible for their own gratuity in the program.


