



How are minority and low-income populations addressed?

Environmental Justice regulations direct that programs, policies, and activities identify and address disproportionately high and adverse human health and environmental effects on minority and low-income populations.

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and subsequent laws prohibit discrimination based on race, color, national origin, age, sex, and disability.



Impacts on Title VI and Environmental Justice communities will be an important consideration when recommending transportation solutions.
