

# Terminology

## Federal Transit Administration (FTA)

An agency within the United States Department of Transportation (DOT) that provides financial and technical assistance to local public transit systems.



# Terminology

## Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO)

Designated by agreement of the Governor and local elected officials that together represent at least 75 percent of the affected population (including the largest incorporated city based on population) or in accordance with State or local law, is the forum for cooperative decision-making. MAG is the designated MPO for transportation planning in the Maricopa County region.



# Terminology

## Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

This is a schedule of specific transportation infrastructure projects to be constructed or implemented across the region over the next three to five years. The TIP must include every capital and operating project for which assistance will be requested from the FTA









**Legend**



- 5311 Non-Urbanized (ADOT DR)


