



Cave Creek | Carefree Transportation Framework Study

Study to Guide Future Transportation Plans in Cave Creek and Carefree

A study is currently under way to evaluate transportation issues and needs in Cave Creek and Carefree and develop a comprehensive transportation master plan (or framework) designed to guide future local and regional planning. The study area also includes a portion of the neighboring community of Scottsdale along the southern boundary of the study area near Carefree Highway.

The study is being conducted by the Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG) in partnership with the Towns of Cave Creek and Carefree and Maricopa County.

Due to the popularity of the area with cyclists and other non-motorized recreational users, and the numerous local special events occurring in the Towns, the study will have an emphasis on improving local and regional bicycle and pedestrian linkages and safety, and special event traffic and parking management.

STUDY OBJECTIVES INCLUDE:

- Continuing development of the regional bike network on Cave Creek Road, Tom Darlington Road and Pima Road, developing a community bike loop around Black Mountain, and enhancing economic activity associated with cycling,
- Developing bicycle and pedestrian linkages between the Cave Creek and Carefree Town Centers while accommodating equestrian use in the Cave Creek Town Core,
- Developing strategies to improve access, parking and safety for the multiple special events in the Towns,
- Evaluating improvement needs to the regional road networks on Cave Creek Road, Tom Darlington Road and Pima Road and
- Recommending improvements for safe pedestrian crossings and business access.
