

PERFORMANCE MEASURES AD HOC COMMITTEE SUMMARY FOR COC BOARD

BACKGROUND

- Committee started meeting in June to determine what the community should measure, especially for CoC and ESG funded programs
- Created a draft list of performance measurements, aligned with HEARTH and HUD's performance measure guidelines
- Waiting for HUD to release HMIS-specific guidelines for data; in the meantime working with data available from APRs and PIT

RECOMMENDATIONS

Reports

- Quarterly reports provided to CoC Board
- Annual reports presented at larger community meeting
 - Determine targets and community standards for following year
- System level reports and broken down by program
 - Program "secret codes" used in first year then named after that
- Who receives reports
 - CoC Board
 - CoC Committee
 - Local governments
 - Other public/private funders
 - Others?

Committee

- Start with Ad Hoc group and add members
- Function would be to analyze data, monitor quality, determine poor performers and action plans
- Possible committee members
 - Academic community, maybe ASU or Morrison Group
 - Data analyst position for CoC (long-term goal)
 - City/county person
 - Public or private funders
 - Provider representative(s)

CoC Structure

- Performance Measurement group should be as close to the CoC Board/ decision making process as possible.
- Open questions:
 - Will this be separate group that's parallel to HMIS Advisory Group? OR
 - Will it be part of HMIS Advisory Group?
