



HMIS Homeless Management Information System


The Maricopa Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) is a program funded by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and managed by Community Information and Referral Services to provide homeless service agencies in Maricopa County with proprietary software to record shelter management data, client intake information, client service records, and reporting.

The HMIS system provides essential information about who is accessing various homeless and housing services, as well as identifies individual and group needs and service gaps.

The Maricopa County HMIS Project has been in existence since 2002 and is a collaborative of more than 50 homeless and low income service providers, over 500 users, and includes more than 100 programs.
