



**Phoenix/Maricopa County Continuum of Care



**Question 3.5: What other stakeholders should be represented on this workgroup?**




**Question 4: How should decisions be made in these workgroups?**




**Question 5: I would like to see a smaller decision-making body that takes input from the activities of this workgroup and makes recommendations to the CoC.**



**Question 6: If you think work group recommendations should be sent to a governing / advisory group, which type of group should make decisions?**




**Question 7: How should the membership of this advisory group be decided?**
