### **Conditional Selection Criteria for Tier 1**

Within the rank order established by the CoC, by CoC score, HUD will select Tier 1 projects in the following order:

1. Renewal projects
2. New reallocated projects
3. CoC planning projects
4. Permanent Housing Bonus Projects in “Extreme High Needs Communities”
5. Permanent Housing Bonus Projects
6. New PH projects
7. New SSO projects for Coordinated Assessment
8. New HMIS projects
9. Net TH projects
10. New SSO projects
