Notice is hereby given that a public workshop will be held at the Maricopa Association Governments, 302 N. 1st Ave., Phoenix, AZ, 2nd floor in the Saguaro room on Thursday, January 12, 2012, from 10:00 a.m. to noon. The workshop will provide training for agencies interested in applying for funds through Section 5310 Elderly Individuals and Individuals with Disabilities Transportation Program (49USC§5310); Section 5316 or Job Access & Reverse Commute/JARC (49USC§5316); and Section 5317, New Freedom (49USC§5317) transportation programs. Assistance is designed to provide or coordinate transportation primarily for older adults and/or individuals with disabilities, and/or low-incomes, unemployed or under-employed persons needing transportation to and from employment or employment-related activities.
