

## Domestic Violence Update for HSCIC Meeting: (For Consent)

Domestic Violence Awareness Month was a great success this year. MAG held the Tech. Safety For Abuse Victims press conference which received strong media coverage, and the region demonstrated solidarity in working to end domestic violence by lighting their communities purple.

At the September meeting of the MAG Regional Domestic Violence Council, the MAG Regional Plan to End Domestic Violence was recommended for approval by the MAG Regional Council at the January meeting. Strategies in the plan include ongoing strategies from the 2010 plan, as well as new strategies to end domestic violence including the provision of technology safety education.

The MAG Misdemeanor Protocol Model is under revision at this time, and there are still opportunities to participate. The revised model will go before the MAG Regional Domestic Violence Council for recommendation of approval in December. The upcoming meetings are scheduled as follows:
