



## GOVERNANCE – NOT GOVERNMENT


- Local governments represent the greatest resource for regional planning in Arizona:

  - Offer leadership on decisions affecting local stakeholders




# MAG Policy Structure

# MAG Committee Structure







- Action agenda to promote strategies to improve the state of human services in the region.


# Human Services Technical Committee

# Continuum of Care Regional Committee on Homelessness



- HEARTH Act Regulated
- Since 1999, received \$322 million for homeless services across the Valley for 60 programs.
- Regional Plan to End Homelessness
- Regional Heat Relief Network includes 80 hydration and refuge locations.



# Elderly & Persons with Disabilities Transportation Committee



- Human Services Transportation Coordination
- Coordinates federal funding
- 2008 Winner of the United We Ride Leadership Award for Major Urbanized Areas
- More than 450 Transportation Ambassador Program participant
