

NEW DRAFT FY 2014-18 TIP

Planning process began in March 2012

- Review of CMP requirements & project criteria identified
- Modal Committee presentations & discussions
- CMAQ Applications released August 6, 2012
- **Working Group Meeting held on August 13, 2012**
- Two additional working group meetings with technical assistance
- Modal Committee reviews, evaluations, AQ scores, recommended ranking, early phase public comment
- Funding estimates from ADOT and RTP distribution updated
- Three years of programming; FY 2015, 2016, and 2017 projects are collected.




CMAQ PROJECTS

- **Flexible funding** for transportation projects & programs to help meet the requirements of the Clean Air Act.
- **Reduce congestion** and **improve air quality** for areas that do not meet the National Ambient Air Quality Standards for ozone, carbon monoxide, or particulate matter (nonattainment areas) and for former nonattainment areas that are now in compliance (maintenance areas).
- **FHWA CMAQ Program - MAG Funds**: FLCP, ALCP & ITS, Transit, Bike/Ped, AQ (Paving, SS, etc.)

Bike/Ped


- \$23,532,117 total;

PM-10 Pave UnPaved Dirt Roads


- \$10,686,128 total

- 29 applications received
- 26 projects funded

Air Quality Program

- CMAQ funds are identified via The Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) for distribution to the Air Quality Program in FY 2015-2017.
- Regional Rideshare, PM-10 Street sweepers, and Travel & Trip Reduction programs total: \$9,523,808.
