




Fast Act Freight Funding

- **Nationally Significant Freight and Highway Projects (NSFWP) Program “FASTLANE GRANTS”**
 - Freight specific competitive grant program with \$4.5 billion over five years.
- **National Highway Freight Program**
 - Freight specific formula program provided with \$6.3 billion over five years.



National Highway Freight Program


Critical Rural and Urban Freight Corridors:

- Serves a major freight generator




