
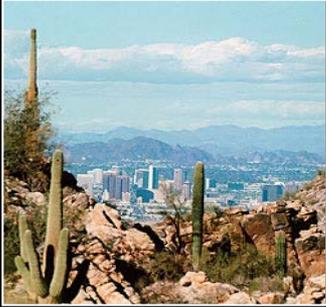




ADEQ Maricopa Ozone Nonattainment Boundary Recommendation-May 23, 2016




- Four options would be recommended by the State to EPA by October 1, 2016.
- Allows for the consideration of newer, more recent air quality data, which may be cleaner.
 - EPA will be evaluating 2014-2016 data and possibly 2017 data and finalize the boundary designation by October 1, 2017.
- If the downward trend continues and the 2 monitors meet the standard, the boundary would not need to be expanded.
- Provides a streamlined approach rather than the State revising its recommendation after it is made.




*If Queen Valley and Gila monitors are both attaining given 2016 design values



*If Gila monitor is not attaining and Queen Valley monitor is attaining given 2016 design values




*If Queen Valley is not attaining and Gila monitor is attaining given 2016 design values.

- Conducted a stakeholder meeting-May 23, 2016.
- Prepared draft designations document-May 31, 2016.
- Public review process-May, June 2016.
- Public hearing-July 1, 2016.
- Submit designations document to Governor-August, September 2016.
- Governor submits to EPA-October 1, 2016.
