




- Meeting was held on June 21 to hear a presentation from Century Link to be considered as the provider of service for 9-1-1.

South Mountain Freeway Awaiting Decision by Judge




- Oral Arguments were heard May 11, 2016.

Tourism & Shopping Initiative



- **MAG consultant, Capitol Strategies, received bipartisan Congressional support for expanding the zone of the Border Crossing Card from 75 miles to the entire State of Arizona.**
- The Congressional letters of support have been submitted to the Office of Homeland Security.
- Expanding the zone will provide an estimated \$181 million per year increase in sales tax for Arizona.
