







# 2013 Regional Employment Concentration & Top 10 Businesses by Location




# 2013 Jobs by Cluster & Subcluster



  - **4 Job Centers production-oriented (33%+)**
  - **43 Job Centers** have an **anchor employer** responsible for at least 33% of jobs

**Total Jobs by Job Center Size**



# Largest Industry Cluster by Job Center (2013 Employment)


