


Recap: What are PUMAs?


- ◆ Public Use Microdata Areas
 - ◆ Tabulation areas for Census 2010 and American Community Survey Public Use Microdata Sample (PUMS) data
 - ◆ PUMS contain records for a sample of housing units with information on the characteristics of each unit and each person in it
 - ◆ PUMS are used in MAG socioeconomic and transportation modeling as the basis for household populations


Methodology

- ◆ Minimum of 100,000 people
- ◆ Maximum of 200,000 people
- ◆ Attempted to follow city boundaries as much as possible
- ◆ Did not conform to 2000 PUMA boundaries




