1. Welcome

The meeting was commenced at 8:30 a.m. by Debbie Albert. All working group members introduced themselves.

2. Report on RCN Phase IA

Lydia Warnick of ADOT provided a brief update on Phase IA of the RCN project. Lydia stated that there are currently two links down, generating from Sky Harbor and Chandler. Lydia is working with the project team to resolve the issues. Lydia stated that the June 14th status meeting will be canceled unless these issues have been resolved.

3. Camera Cameleon Update

Lydia stated that testing on the west valley ring has commenced.

4. No-Cost Service Additions Submission Process Update

Audrey Skidmore stated that no additional comments were received since the previous meeting. Audrey stated that the June 1st joint meeting of the Intelligent Transportation Systems committee and the Technology Advisory Group did not obtain a quorum to approve the no-cost service additions. She added that either another joint meeting needs to be scheduled or the committees can approve the additions separately.

5. Expansion discussion

Audrey stated that close out funds are not available and the goal is get a project added to the 2015 Transportation Improvement Program. Sarath added that due to the EPA rejecting MAG's dust-pollution cleanup plan, no new projects can currently be added to the TIP. Lydia stated that Scottsdale is close to being ready for connection. Debbie asked about the status of the fiber on I-10 to determine potential RCN connectivity for Avondale and Goodyear. Lydia stated that there is a gap of both fiber and conduit between 99th Avenue and Dysart Road. Debbie suggested having the ITS and TAG committees determine locations which are close to being added to the RCN.

6. Discussion items for next meeting

Subjects for discussion include an update on the project and a Camera Cameleon testing update. Additionally the Working Group will continue to discuss future expansion and the formal process to submit no-cost service additions.
