Location of Survey Respondents - Metro Area










Satisfied/Very Satisfied with Services




Q1N Satisfaction with Community/Senior Center Services






Dissatisfied/Very Dissatisfied with Services



Q4D Losing the ability to drive







Current Most Frequent Modes of Transportation vs. Projected in Ten Years



Current Most Frequent Use of Services vs. Projected in 10 Years




Lighter colors represent 2012 use. Darker colors represent 2020 projections.






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
Age of Respondents


Race of Respondents

■ Caucasian ■ African American ■ Other ■ Asian/Pacific Islander ■ Native American




Hispanic Ethnicity
