

- Thanks to Wickenburg and Surprise for hosting tours.





# Per Capita GDP Relative to US Average







# U.S. Secretary of Transportation Awards MAG Integrated Corridor Management (ICM) Deployment Planning Grant



- MAG to receive \$200,000 grant for the I-10 Corridor.
- Purpose is for application of ICM knowledge, technology transfer for analysis, modeling and simulation.
- Project will use technology to achieve safe flow in the I-10 corridor from Santan and I-10 to the 101 and I-10, including the adjoining streets.
- 13 successful project teams were chosen nationally.
- MAG partners include, FHWA, ADOT, Maricopa County, Phoenix, Chandler, Tempe, Valley Metro and DPS.



- \$1.9 billion project
