






Household Travel Survey



- MAG is surveying 7,000 households regarding travel behavior.
- Pilot Survey was successfully completed.
- Letters for the main survey will be sent to households starting this month.
- Participating households will be asked to record their travel and verify it has been accurately captured.
- Participants can choose between a cell phone application or a GPS logger.

U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Grant



- The Maricopa Regional Continuum of Care was awarded **\$21,818,193** in homeless assistance funding from HUD
- Provides funding for local housing and service programs aimed at ending homelessness
- Thirty-eight projects will receive between **\$35,000** and **\$3,068,002**
- Coordinated Entry, a process by which we prioritize those seeking homeless services, was funded in the amount of **\$855,158**
- A second round of funding announcements are expected in the Spring





PM-10 Lawsuit



- Being considered for the week of June 13-17th
- 25 exceptional event days were documented between 2011-2012
- June 2014, EPA approved the MAG 2012 Five Percent Plan for PM-10 for the Maricopa County Nonattainment Area.
- July 29, 2014, the Arizona Center for Law in the Public Interest filed a lawsuit challenging EPA's approval of the Plan.
- The Court has not decided if MAG is an Intervenor or Friend of the Court.
