









Survey Results




There were 87 total participants. Sixty completed the survey.

Average Employment Period




Advocacy training received *during* the 1st year

■ Yes, received training. ■ No, did not receive.




Advocacy training received *after* the 1st year

■ Yes, received training. ■ No, did not receive




Current rate of training




Barriers to training

Preferred approaches to training




Other

Preferred types of training




Other
