SUBJECT: VICE CHAIR VACANCY

As of December 31, 2012, the position of vice chair of the Domestic Violence Council will be vacant. Police Chief Jerald Monahan from the City of Apache Junction will be stepping down after one-year of the vice chair's two-year term. According to the MAG Committee Operating Policies and Procedures, the MAG Regional Council Executive Committee will appoint a new vice chair to complete the remainder of the two-year term. Letters of interest for vice chair of the Domestic Violence Council are being solicited from MAG member agencies. These letters are requested to be submitted to the attention of Mayor Marie Lopez Rogers, MAG Chair, at the MAG offices located at 302 N. 1st Avenue, Suite 300, Phoenix, Arizona 85003 by Wednesday, December 19, 2012. At their January 22, 2013 meeting, the MAG Executive Committee will be requested to appoint a new vice chair of the Domestic Violence Council.

The MAG Committee Operating Policies and Procedures discussed above were adopted by the MAG Regional Council on July 22, 2009. The approval of these policies and procedures modifies, and in some cases, clarifies the understanding and former practice of several MAG processes, including officer appointments. Appointment of officers for technical and policy committees, with the exception of the Transportation Policy Committee, will be made by the MAG Executive Committee. The officer positions have two-year terms.
