2014 Proposed Protocol Evaluation Project Overview**

Goal #1: Maintain and update the domestic violence misdemeanor protocol model.

- Activity 1: Assess implementation survey results to determine law enforcement agencies' progress in expanding use of the regional protocol model.
- Activity 2: Convene a leadership group with partners such as Arizona Coalition Against Domestic Violence, Arizona Criminal Justice Commission, Arizona Prosecuting Attorney's Advisory Council, Arizona Chiefs of Police Association, Arizona Peace Officer Standards and Training Board, and the O'Connor House.
- Activity 3: Convene affinity group meetings with law enforcement, prosecutors, and victim advocates.
- Activity 4: Refine the Regional Protocol Model.

Goal #2: Support effective implementation of the felony domestic violence protocols by analyzing opportunities to improve communication and training of law enforcement, prosecutors, and victim advocates.

- Activity 5: Convene community meetings to support Maricopa County Attorney's Office in making revisions to the felony protocols.

Goal #3: Improve the criminal justice system's coordinated community response to domestic violence by staffing the MAG Regional Domestic Violence Council.

- Activity 6: Staff MAG Regional Domestic Violence Council meetings, activities, and special events.

Goal #4: Continue to identify ways to improve domestic violence data collection.

- Activity 7: Conduct a survey with survivors to assess the criminal justice system's response to domestic violence crimes.

Goal #5: Coordinate and support opportunities to expand the impact of the project statewide by working with the Arizona Coalition Against Domestic Violence, Arizona Criminal Justice Commission, Arizona Prosecuting Attorney's Advisory Council, Arizona Chiefs of Police Association, and Arizona Peace Officer Standards and Training Board.

- Activity 8: Collaboratively coordinate and conduct trainings for victim advocates, law enforcement, and prosecutors by partnering with agencies such as the Arizona Coalition Against Domestic Violence, the O'Connor House, the Arizona Coalition for Victim Services, Arizona Prosecuting Attorney's Advisory Council and Arizona Peace Officers Standards and Training Board.
