ALCP Overview

- The ALCP serves as the financial management tool for the arterial component of the RTP
- The program contains 198 projects across 13 jurisdictions
- The program is guided by the ALCP Policies and Procedures



Street Committee Role

- The ALCP Policies and Procedures require that all requests to change original ALCP project scope or a substitute a project in the ALCP must meet be presented to the MAG Street Committee for a technical review and recommendation

Key Program Policies

- Updates and amendments must be consistent with the RTP (Section 100)
- Eligible Projects include:
 - Major Arterials
 - Roadway facilities on the regional arterial or mile arterial grid system
 - Roadway facilities that connect freeways, highways or other controlled access facilities
 - Other key arterial corridors
 - Intersections of eligible major arterials
