Subject: Notification of FY 2016 Section 5310 Mobility Management Supplemental Application

The purpose of this notice is to announce a call for projects for a FY 2016 Section 5310 Mobility Management Supplemental application for the Central Valley in the Phoenix-Mesa UZA. On May 4, 2016, the Elderly and Persons with Disabilities Committee recommended funding available for a supplemental call for projects for a Central Valley Mobility Management position due to not receiving an application submittal during the annual call for project. On June 2, 2016, the MAG Regional Council approved the availability of funding for Mobility Management position for the Central Valley to ensure the continuation of regional support of human services transportation coordination activities, as federally required.

The potential mobility management applicant will offer support for regional human services transportation coordination efforts with a focus on the Central Valley. Mobility management activities consist of offering input to address regional concerns and engaging providers in coordination planning for the population of older adults and people with disabilities community. The area of focus for the Central Valley include the general Phoenix area and adjacent communities. The match ratio for this grant award is 80 percent federal and 20 percent local. The availability of funding is \$36,000 federal and \$9,000 local for a combined total of \$45,000.

The Section 5310 Supplemental Mobility Management application and handbook is tentatively set to be released on September 2, 2016. Please note regional coordination participation is a requirement for the Section 5310 program.
