

# Transportation 2050

- Proposition 104 approved by Phoenix voters in August 2015
- Plan identifies both **transit** and **street** improvements



# The Process

- Citizens Committee on the Future of Phoenix Transportation (CCFPT)
- Commenced August 2014
- Public Participation
  - Before & after CCFPT Plan
  - On-line & In-person
  - Over 100 meetings
  - Over 3,700 residents




# The Plan

- 0.7% Sales Tax
- 35 Years
- Street Improvements
- Bus and Dial-A-Ride Service Enhancements
- Light Rail Extensions




# Phoenix Major Street Improvement Plan



- Repave all major streets
- Improves maintenance cycle citywide, including local streets
- Will prolong the life of all city streets

- Improved peak and weekend frequency
- New routes to “fill out the grid”
- Dial-A-Ride improvements





# Transportation 2050 Funding


- The Transportation 2050 0.7% tax begins Jan. 1, 2016
- Estimates show individual cost will be \$4-5 a month
- Leverages \$14.8 billion in rider fares, federal, regional and other funds



# How will that 3 percent be spent?

- Majority of additional funds support new/enhanced bus service
- New funds for street repair, sidewalk and bike lane installation
- Funds operation and maintenance of 42 miles of new light rail

## Next Steps

- Citizens' Transportation Commission oversight on plan
- 38 miles of new pavement and 40 miles of new bike lanes
- Review dates of approved light rail corridors
- Extend bus and Dial-a-Ride hours
- Increase weekend local bus service frequencies
- Shade 30 bus shelters
