SUBJECT: CALL FOR PROJECTS: MAG FEDERAL FUNDS

The Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG) is accepting applications for the Pinal County Surface Transportation Program (STP). Funding is available for projects within the Pinal County portion of the MAG planning area.

A Pre-Application Workshop will be held on **Tuesday, March 10, 2015 from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.** in the MAG Offices, 302 North 1st Avenue, Suite 200 – Cottonwood Room, to discuss and explain the applications. It is suggested that all potential applicant agencies send at least one representative to attend this workshop. Presentation information and a question and answer session will be provided.

Additionally, an open working group with staff assistance for agencies completing applications will available on **Monday, March 23, 2015 from 1:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.** at the MAG Offices, 302 North 1st Avenue, Suite 200 – Cottonwood Room, to assist those agencies needing one on one, and small group assistance with completing applications. It is suggested that potential applicant agencies send a representative to attend this working group if application assistance is needed. No formal presentations will be provided.

The completed spreadsheet applications and signed, completed, printed versions of the applications are due at the MAG Offices, 302 North 1st Avenue, Suite 300, Phoenix, AZ, 85003, **by Monday, April 6, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. Late applications will not be accepted.**

An estimated \$5.7 million is available between FY 2017 and FY 2019, The available funding does include the un-programmed carry-forward from Fiscal Years 2014 through 2016.




