





Please provide your comments before noon on Friday, September 4th, 2015.



Summary of Questions/Comments

- Make traveling between 7th Ave. and 7th St. easier for walkers by using protected lanes.
- We need more dedicated bike paths in the Valley, not just lanes.
- I urge MAG and ADOT to work together to complete I-10 to three lanes in each direction as soon as possible.
- Please get all the cities to manage their left turn arrows on their street lights the same way.



Questions/Comments

- Increase bike lanes and makes them safer by using a barrier between bikes and traffic.
- Please pave the entire Aguila Road between Vulture Mine Road and Eagle Eye Road.
- There needs to be a regional paratransit system.
- Dust ordinances need to be strictly enforced.
