1. Call to Order

Chairman Tim Tilton called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m.

2. Call to the Audience

There were no requests to address the MAG POPTAC Ad Hoc Subcommittee.

3. Approval of Minutes of December 6, 2005

It was moved by Mark Fooks, seconded by Sam Andreas and unanimously recommended to approve the meeting minutes of December 6, 2005.

4. July 1, 2005 Resident Population Updates

Anubhav Bagley noted that the State requires official resident population annually. He commented that the updates would be used to distribute state-shared revenues for those jurisdictions not conducting a Special Census or a Census Survey. He also noted that DES is still required to prepare July 1, 2005 annual population updates for Maricopa County.

Mr. Bagley explained that at the December 2, 2005 meeting of the DES POPTAC, the accuracy of the data input used by DES to prepare the estimates was raised. However,

because of a December 15, 2005 state mandated deadline, DES forwarded the estimates to the Economic Estimates Commission. DES staff also indicated that the estimates would be revised to reflect corrected data. Tim Tilton stated that it is essential that the methodology for the estimates used by DES is good and applied correctly.
