


Interagency Planning Agreements

- **The interagency agreements are listed with the associated UPWP project number:**
 - **600.920** - Planning Support Agreement - Valley Metro Rail (VMR)
 - **600.150** - Planning Support Agreement – Regional Public Transportation Authority (RPTA)
 - **600.130** - Regional Bicycle Planning, Bike Safety Education Agreement – RPTA
 - **500.130** - Regional Rideshare Program Agreement – RPTA
 - **Appendix** - Resolution on Metropolitan Transportation Planning and Programming (RPTA, VMR, City of Phoenix)



Interagency Planning Agreements



- The FTA/FHWA funded interagency planning agreements are aligned with the goals and priorities identified in the Regional Transportation Plan.



Interagency Planning Agreements

- **The Regional Transportation Plan identifies four major goal areas - the corresponding interagency agreement & inception date are listed:**
 - System preservation and safety.
 - Access and mobility – 500.130 Regional Rideshare (RPTA) FY 2001
 - Sustaining the environment - 600.130 Regional Bike Education (RPTA) FY 2002
 - Accountability and planning – 600.150 Planning Support (RPTA) FY 2001; 600.920 Planning Support (VMR) FY 2006; * Resolution on Metropolitan Transportation Planning & Programming FY 2006





Interagency Planning Agreements

- **Resolution on Metropolitan Transportation Planning and Programming**
 - This agreement is being revised for Transit Planning and Programming, and funding allocations – the agreement will be between MAG, RPTA, VMR, City of Phoenix and other transit operators in the valley, and will be incorporated into the UPWP.





Interagency Planning Agreements



- The ADOT/MAG Agreement is due for renewal beginning fiscal year 2011. This agreement will be effective July 1, 2010. ADOT has advised MAG that they will work with MAG throughout the current year on any updates to the new agreement. To-date, MAG has not received any information on the update of this agreement.
- There were no substantive changes between the current agreement and the initial agreement effective July 2000.




Changes in Organizational Structure

2004






Changes in Organizational Structure

Staff FTE






MAG Policy Structure
