




# Outbound Freight from the MAG Region: Top Ten Destination States




# Inbound Freight to the MAG Region: Top Ten Origin States

- Loop 303 to I-17 (4+1)
- Broadway Curve Under Study
  - (local express lanes additional 6 lanes)
- US-60 to Riggs Rd (4+1)

  - Gila Bend Bypass (under study)






