

**Maricopa Association of Governments Building Codes Committee Resolution**

WHEREAS all member jurisdictions of the Maricopa Association of Governments Building Codes Committee have adopted either the 1997 Uniform Building Code or any edition of the International Building Code; AND

WHEREAS all of the above referenced Building Codes require special inspection for structural steel, subject to the requirements and alternatives established by the aforementioned codes; AND

WHEREAS each of the aforementioned codes do not require the special inspections on shop fabricated portions of structural steel if these items subject to special inspection are fabricated on the premises of an "approved" fabrication shop; AND

WHEREAS the City of Phoenix administers a program that generates and maintains a list of approved steel fabricators that meet some or all of the following approvals: AISC, City of Los Angeles, Clark County (Nevada), ICC IAS or some other authority approved by the City of Phoenix; AND

WHEREAS the City of Phoenix Approved Steel Fabricators program requires that each and every fabricated piece of steel shall be identified to indicate the shop of origin;

BE IT SO RESOLVED by the Committee that member jurisdictions will recognize and accept the City of Phoenix Approved Structural Steel Fabricators program and list as meeting the special structural inspections alternatives for structural steel fabricated by an approved fabricator as allowed in the building codes. This resolution shall have an effective date of July 1, 2006.
